Guidance for students if requested to attend jury service for students on Faculty of Health and Human Sciences Programmes

From time to time students are called for jury service. Jurors are selected at random by Her Majesty's Courts Service from the electoral register and everyone on the electoral register between the ages of 18 to 76 may be selected.

Where jury service is likely to interfere with your study or assessment, you may seek deferral of your service. The Jury Central Summoning Bureau evaluates any requests for deferral and those requests may usually be for **no longer than 12 months**.

Students can no longer gain "exemption" from jury service on grounds of being in healthcare environments. Please speak to your Personal Tutor or Programme Lead as soon as possible.
