Examples of research led, orientated, tutored and based teaching		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students engage in a research study using an ethically approved protocol produced in the year 2 'Project Studies' module. • Students are taught the ethical implications of carrying out a research study. • Students will critically analyse, evaluate and synthesise the results of their study and understand its context in the wider literature. • Students will demonstrate their ability to work collaboratively with their peers and supervisor in a professional manner. 		
Assessment of research-informed teaching		
Students complete a small research study relevant to their future profession in line with an ethically approved protocol. They work collaboratively to produce a research report in a format suitable for publication in an academic journal. They then undergo a viva to discuss their research project		
Benefits to staff and students		
Students who achieve a high mark in their group report and/or individual presentation will be offered the opportunity to submit an abstract for a presentation/poster to a conference or submit their journal article to an appropriate journal for publication.
