

PAHC Student Free Bus Scheme 2019-20



The University of Plymouth offers a free intersite bus service between Drake Circus campus and Plymouth Marjon University where the Peninsula Allied Health Centre (PAHC) is situated.

PAHC students are issued with a University of Plymouth card with a bus logo on it to denote eligibility to use the free bus scheme.



The scheme provides travel between University of Plymouth and the Peninsula Allied Health Centre (PAHC) and Derriford Hospital only, ie the link between the city centre and the Northern Campus

Services can only be accessed via Royal Parade, North Hill, Cobourg Street/Station approach, Mutley Plain, Derriford Hospital, Plymouth Marjon University and Runway Road

Please note the scheme **does not** cover:

- Travel from your home address or around any other area in Plymouth
- Travel from the Park and Ride services at Coypool, Milehouse or George Junction.
- Travel at weekends

PARKING AT PAHC

Please note that there is no student parking at PAHC.

There is a Pay & Display car park at the University of St Mark & St John, which currently charges £5 per day and is open to all.

PARK AND RIDE

George Junction Park & Ride

Target Travel operates the **PR3** park and ride bus service from George Junction to Plymouth Marjon University and Derriford Hospital.

This is not part of the free student bus service.

George Junction Park & Ride car park is within walking distance of PAHC via Runway Road.
