Should you wish to start a language please seek advice from a member of the Modern Languages staff regarding level of entry. Languages available at beginner level are: French 1 - FREX01 and Spanish 1 - SPNX01. If you choose to take up a beginner language module, you will be asked by the Languages' Group staff to fill out a form detailing previous experience / qualifications.

If you wish to continue with your language please note the available modules are FREX02, and SPNX02.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR DIRECT ENTRANT INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

If you are a Direct Entrant International Student, you are strongly advised in semester 1 to choose:

ELC315 Professional and Academic Communication (20 credits)

instead of a language module, and in semester 2 you are strongly advised to select either:

ELC312 English for Global Communication (20 credits), or
ELC314 International Business Communication (20 credits)

English modules (ELC312, ELC314 and ELC315) are only available to students whose native language is not English. If you need more guidance, please speak to an English Language Centre lecturer or your programme manager.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE MODULE CHOICES YOU SUBMIT BY THE DEADLINE ARE BINDING. SHOULD YOU SUBSEQUENTLY REQUEST TO CHANGE MODULES, IT CANNOT BE GUARANTEED THAT YOUR TIMETABLE WILL NOT CLASH AND YOU MAY BE ASKED TO RESELECT MODULES.

ANY ELECTIVE MODULES WHICH DO NOT RECRUIT 20 STUDENTS MAY BE CANCELLED, AND STUDENTS WILL BE REQUESTED TO SELECT ANOTHER ELECTIVE. ALL ELECTIVE MODULES ARE OFFERED SUBJECT TO SUFFICIENT STUDENT DEMAND AND THE AVAILABILITY OF APPROPRIATE STAFF EXPERTISE.
