To appeal against the decision of the Award Assessment Board, you must do so by the published deadline on the Faculty Result's page.

- **Extenuating Circumstances**

If you have submitted valid extenuating circumstances during the year, these will have been considered by the Award Assessment Board.

- **Return to the programme**

You must complete your programme within six years of your first enrolment which includes any outstanding practice time that needs to be made up. Students expecting to return in September 2021 should already have contacted the School of Health Professions.

If it is your intention to return at a later date please contact the school six months before you expect to return. Please notify the school of your planned return using the mail addresses at the end of this sheet.

Any return to the programme will be subject to available vacancies. Satisfactory enhanced Disclosure and Barring Services (DBS) and Occupational Health checks will also be required.

Please note an interrupt to study is normally for no more than one year. If we do not receive notification of your intention to return at the end of this period we will assume you are withdrawing from your programme and will take appropriate action.
