When you are developing your resources, think carefully about who they are for – will children or adults be reading them? Will particular resources be needed? Are there any safety concerns you would like to highlight?

Using images can often help to get your ideas across. If you are using images found on the internet, check that these can be shared freely. Please do not include children in your photographs as it is difficult to ensure that they fully understand the implications of agreeing to share their image.
