# Important information regarding your results

- **Confirmation of Marks**

Please see the above link for a detailed explanation of the policies and procedures leading to the publication of your results.

- **Compensated Pass**

- If the Award Assessment Board has made the decision to award you a compensated pass this will be shown on your transcript as the module decision code of CP.
- This means that you have achieved a mark of between 30%-39% in up to 20 credits; therefore, allowing you to be compensated for the module(s) as in order to pass a module, you are required to achieve an overall module mark of at least 40%.
- Under the University's regulations however, you have the option to either accept the compensated pass in the module(s) listed, or undertake the module again as a referral at the next opportunity (referral in the failed element(s) only). Choosing the latter option may mean that you increase your overall final stage mark which may then have an effect on your overall degree classification. Any elements taken at the second or third attempt will be capped at the pass mark, normally 40%. You should consider this option carefully as any marks obtained by undertaking the referral will be used when calculating your final award even if they are subsequently lower than the original marks gained. You should contact IUG if you have any queries.

If you wish to undertake a referral in the failed element(s) rather than accept the compensated pass, please contact **IUG** details no later than **Monday, 7th September 2020**.

- **Graduation Ceremony**

Please contact **IUG** for details of the graduation ceremony.

- **Appeals**

If you wish to appeal against the decision of the Award Assessment Board, you must do so by **1st September 2020**.

- **Extenuating Circumstances**

If you have submitted valid extenuating circumstances during the year, these will have been considered by the Award Assessment Board.
