This tab records all of the standards that

- have been achieved (Green)
- are looking to be achieved (Orange)
- have not been achieved (red)

How is the Grid fed?

Evidence Tab

When your student uploads a piece of evidence for you to mark in the Evidence tab, the grid will show an orange block against the relevant standard on their grid to show that they are waiting for this evidence to be looked at.

If you mark this piece of evidence 'Sufficient' the orange block will change to green to show that the student has achieved this standard.


If you mark this piece of evidence 'Insufficient' the orange block will change to red to show that the student has not achieved this standard yet.

Monitoring & Evaluation Tab

When you complete a Monitoring & Evaluation, you will link the standard(s) that you have observed and this will show as a green block on your student's Grid.

Students must have two green blocks against a standard to achieve it. If the same standard is attached to more evidence/Monitoring & Evaluation it will not increase the amount of green blocks you will see.
