
*Question ideas to help your child during the 'Stick Man' activity.
This week's book is Stick Man by Julia Donaldson.*

This week to support your children's play we have asked your child to get creative and go outdoors, this could be on a walk or in the garden! They could take photographs of nature and then draw a picture based on the photographs or they could make a collage out of sticks, twigs, and leaves etc. They might want to make their very own stick person!

Where are we going on our adventure?

What colour are the leaves today?

If you made a stick person, what is your stick person's name?

What is the weather like today? Is it hot or cold? Can you feel the wind? It is sunny or cloudy?

What does it feel like? What texture is it? Is it smooth? Rough? Cold? Hot? Bumpy? Hard? Soft?

What can you smell?

What are we taking on our adventure? water, food, wellies, hand sanitizer?

What are you going to make out of the nature you find?

What sounds can you hear? Can you hear the wind, birds, trees moving in the wind or people?

Who else is coming on our adventure?

What is your favourite weather? Do you like it when it is snowing, raining, sunny, foggy, or windy?

What else can you see?
