



# Whatever Next



This week to support your child's play we have asked your child to go on adventure inside, this may be to the beach, under the sea, Space etc. This could be as a household or a solo adventure. This week's theme is based on the book 'Whatever Next!' by Jill Murphy.

We have asked your child to produce a form of transport to travel in, to pack a suitcase or bag and to create a passport. The adventure can be to a real world location for example, somewhere they may have visited before on a holiday or a place they may not have visited e.g., space. Additionally, the location can be an imaginary land which your child has fully made up. If possible, please join your child on their indoor adventure and ask questions to promote learning.



This activity aims to promote freedom, creativity, imaginary play and development of their story telling / narrative skills. Your child has freedom this week to determine where their adventure may lead them and to create based on their own experiences and/or interests. This activity has a multitude of possibilities, wherever will the adventure take your child next?

In these examples we have used natural and recyclable materials such as twigs, paper cups, plastic bottles, cardboard boxes and foil. Your child could use objects from around the home, such as wicker baskets or a laundry hamper. Your child could even make a scene scape, for example of the beach or of a jungle, or they could use their full imagination. Their vehicles can be of any size/scale, they could imagine themselves in them or make it, so they are able to ride/sail/drive/fly them.

Where are you going to go next? What's the name of the place?

What are you going to make for your travels? Are you going to build a rocket to get there, or maybe a unicorn or dinosaur to travel with?

How are you going to travel?

Who is coming with you?

What food are you going to take with you? What food(s) do your family/friends coming with you like?

What will the weather be like?

What clothes will you need to wear?

What are you going to pack for your adventure?



What do you think you will find on your adventure?

Who may you meet while on your adventure?

Have you travelled there before?

How long will it take to travel there?

(When arrived) What can you smell? What can you hear? What can you feel?

After this adventure, where will you go next?

Did you enjoy your adventure? Do you want to go there again?
