there?

Who is coming with you?

What are you going to make for
your travels? Are you going to build a
rocket to get there, or maybe a unicorn
or dinosaur to travel with? Use your
imagination, this is your story.

After this adventure, what
adventure will you go on next?

What will the weather be like? Hot
cold? - What clothes will you need to
wear?

Did you enjoy your adventure? Do
you want to go again?
