## Before you arrive:

- Research what Higher Education (HE) institutions you may be interested in going to
- Look into particular courses you may want to study
- Check which institutions will be at the UCAS exhibition
- You can do this on the UCAS website – [www.ucas.com](http://www.ucas.com)
- Plan a route around the exhibition centre, prioritising your top 5 institutions – they are usually arranged in alphabetical order

## Questions to ask universities:

- Do you offer the course I'm interested in?
- What are the entry requirements?
- How far away is the accommodation?
- Can I do a placement/study abroad?
- When is the open day?
- What is the city like?
- What is the social life like?

## UCAS Exhibition information:

- Exhibitor lists are available before your UCAS convention from the UCAS website
- You only have an hour and a half in the fair, plan where you want to go and which talks you want to watch
- Don't go wherever your friends go, speak to institutions that you are interested in
- Universities will ask to scan your barcode so they can send you relevant information – make sure it is easily accessible
- Don't be afraid to say no. If you're not interested in the university, they won't mind if you say no to a prospectus or to scan your barcode
